All horses must be NSH Registered with the SHC of Australasia before the close of Entries

ALL Owners, Riders, Exhibitors and Responsible officers must be a member of a SHC Affiliate before close of entries.

SHC Competitors Assoc. Inc. Membership Forms can be downloaded from website www.shccompetitorsassociation.com

Entry is voluntary. By entering all Owners/Exhibitors/Lessee/Competitors/Handlers/Responsible Officers agree to be bound & compete in accordance with, SHC of Australasia Competition Rules, (available from SHC site www.showhorsecouncilaust.com.au), and the General Rules & Rules and Regulations of SHC Competitors Assoc. Inc. applicable to this show.

NEWCOMER A Newcomer has not been shown in a ridden class at any show prior to 1st Jan. 2017. Horses shall be shown in a simple snaffle

LEADING REIN Riders and Handlers competing in the Leading Rein must be full financial members and horses must be NSH Reg. Only simple ring snaffle or egg butt bit to be used. Lead must be attached to noseband. No spurs or whips, handler may carry a cane up to 40cm in length. Exhibitors must choose between Show Pony Leading Rein and Show Hunter Leading Rein, both classes will qualify for Grand National 2015.

FIRST RIDDEN Simple Snaffle, No Willkie or Boucher bits. No Spurs. Whips allowed up to 40cm

SHOW HUNTER/SHOW HORSE from January 1st each year competitors must choose to compete as either a Show Horse or Show Hunter for the entire year.

SHETLAND Any pony competing in the Ridden Shetland class must be registered with APSB Soc. as a Shetland pony.

CHILD'S CLASSES Whips not exceeding 72cms. (Excluding flap) and Spurs may be used.

GRAND NATIONAL QUALIFYING CLASSES

To compete in any Grand National Qualifying class (including Rider & Leading Rein classes) HORSES MUST BE NATIONAL SADDLE HORSE REGISTERED (Show Horse Council of Australasia Inc.) at close of entries. Copy of N.S.H Registration must accompany entry form. Show Hunters are NOT eligible to compete in Show Horse classes & vice versa.

HEIGHT CERTIFICATES

ALL HORSES MUST HAVE A CURRENT SHOW HORSE COUNCIL HEIGHT CERTIFICATE before they can collect numbers and compete.

EA height certificates will not be accepted. Interstate horses must have a current SHC height cert.

RIDERS Rider ages will be taken on the first day of the show.

The mount for a Rider under 9 yrs. must not exceed 14h. The mount for a Rider 9yrs & under 12yrs must not exceed 15hh

ONE RIDER - ONE HORSE FOR ANY CLASS- No rider may ride more than one horse in any class.

The same rider must be on the horse for the Go around and the Workout.

No rider can be substituted or changed once entries have closed without committee approval

No rider may be substituted or changed once the class has commenced.

ATTIRE Safety approved helmets must be worn by all competitors when exercising. Appropriate footwear must be worn by everyone when lunging and riding. Top Hats or Safety approved helmets are permitted for riders 17yrs and over.

Safety approved helmets must be worn by competitors under 17yrs when competing.

SPURS Spurs must not exceed 2cm in length. Rollers are permitted.

SWABBING will be carried out on the Winner or Runner up of classes at random.

The Responsible person present during the swabbing procedure must be 18 years or older and a member of SHC or affiliate.

PROTESTS Protests shall be in writing to the Ground Jury accompanied by \$100 & received no later than 30 minutes after awards have been made.

HENDRA Note: Any horse travelling from Qld. or NSW to SA within the 30 days prior to the show must produce a Hendra vaccination certificate. Failure to do so will render the exhibit ineligible to compete.

NO REFUNDS AFTER ENTRIES HAVE CLOSED FOR ANY REASON

NO LUNGING ON OVAL AT ANYTIME – Any Entry found to be lunging on the arena will be eliminated from competition.

STABLING TO BE ARRANGED VIA SHOW SECRETARY :

****Measuring is only available on the day between 6.30 am and 8am. Measuring is n/a outside these times on the day of competition**

**** Measuring may be made available on the Friday afternoon before competition.**
