BEACH FISHING COMP. RULES 6th - 7th FEB. 2016

- 1. Competition Times: A. Start: Sat. 6th February. 12.00 p.m. to 6.30 p.m.)
 - B. Finish 10.00 a.m. Sunday 7th February.
 - C. Weigh-in 11.00 a.m. Sunday 7th Feb. 2016. Quinn's Beach near surf club
- 2. All competitors must sign on Sat. 6th Feb. 12.00 pm to 6.30 pm by text message or calling 0407283435
- 3. The club Captain, Safety Officer or the Angling & Sports member running the competition has the right to cancel a competition in the event of weather incline.
- 4. Competition is open to any immediate friend's family members as single competitors.
- 5. Boundaries: Between Scarborough beach and Moore river.
- 6. There will be 5 (Five) competition divisions: Most unusual fish, Junior's heaviest, Men's heaviest, Ladies heaviest and most Species. (Weight is based on 1 point per gram. up to 1 kilo per fish only).

7. WEIGHABLE:

- **A. One bag limit as per W.A. fisheries rules per angler.
- **B. A mutilated fish is not eligible for weighing in (a mutilated fish is by means of flesh_piece(s) missing from Shark bites or alike or damaged by boat propeller etc.)
- **C. Undersized fish are ineligible when bought into the weigh-in area and will DISQUALIFY THE CATCH IN ITS ENTIRETY (Remember a just size fish can shrink about 25mm, so remember to re-check your catch, prior to entering into the weighing-in area.)
- **D. Fish that have their neck broken will be pushed back into original shape and must be 1 cm longer than the listed minimum size. This also applies to gilled and gutted fish with the throat cut for bleeding.
- 8. Fish presented for weighing-in MUST BE in an INOFFENSIVE STATE or the weigh-in officer has the right to refuse to weigh the catch until deemed suitable. Bags must be wet to preserve your catch. (Plastic bags of any form are deemed NOT SUITABLE.). Eskies with ice or wet cloth bag or hession bags are preferred
- 9. The Field Officer has the right to check any bags.
- 10. It is the duty of the competitor(s) to notify the weigh master of a possible Club Record to be weighed separately.
- 11. Cleaning of any fish near the launching ramps or in or around the weigh-in area is not permitted unless collecting fish frames.
- 12. Fish can only be caught on a rod and reel (not electric) or hand line(s) with a maximum of two (2) per angler and a maximum of two (2) flights (hook lines) or artificial bait or lures or flies etc.).
