REPOSITIONING OF CONCERTINA DOOR:

Committee has made the decision to reposition the large concertina door that is occasionally used to separate the main carpeted area from the floorboard area. With the addition of the new Slice scoring computer and printer being located in the front section of the floorboard space, we believe that when functions are being held, there is a security and safety issue. By repositioning the concertina door, we can close off and secure this front section with little impact on the entertainment area during functions.

These works will take place within the next 2 weeks.

PRIMARY SCHOOL GOLF EVENT:

Golf Victoria will hold and administer a Primary Schools golf event at our course on **Monday 6th May**. This event will be a Multi-tee start using the front 9 only, starting at 9:15am. The front 9 will be closed until approximately 11:30am on this day, however the Back 9 will be available for members and visitors.
